

Report from HSS Student Advisory Council 2011-2012 Activities and Accomplishments

In 2011-2012 the HSS Student Advisory Council took part in several discussions happening throughout the school. SAC members sat on both the Diversity Committee and the Curriculum Committee, representing students on each. An SAC member also served on the Ad-Hoc Governance Task Force which created the Governance Advisory Council, which a student also served on to represent the student voice in all school-wide policy issues that were brought to the Council.
