



KEY DATES

- 3/5/2024: Beginning of Shopping Cart Period for Fall 2024; registration holds and enrollment appointments visible in PAWS
- 3/25/2024: Quick Enroll for Fall 2024 is enabled for staff
- 4/2/2024: Student Enrollment Appointments Begin
- 4/12/2024: Student Enrollment Appointments End
- 5/3/2024: Late Registration Fine (\$150) Assessed students should enroll in at least one Fall 2024 course by 5/3 to avoid the fine
- Late July: Initial Fall 2024 billing

REMINDERS

- The application for graduation is open for May 2024, August 2024, and December 2024 conferral. Students are encouraged to apply early.
- Students with a graduation term earlier than Fall 2024 will not be able to enroll for Fall 2024. Any student who needs to change their graduation date in PAWS should re-apply for graduation for the correct term, and contact recreg@tcnj.edu in order to be activated for the Fall 2024 term.
- FYW and FYS requirement service indicators continue to be in use. These are informational holds and will have no impact on a student's ability to register.
- Initial Fall 2024 billing will occur in late July. Students should be mindful of payment deadlines to avoid late payment fines. Students who do not make payment arrangements by the final payment due date are subject to deregistration.
