REQUIREMENTS

- 1. While admission to all TCNJ programs is determined via a holistic approach, 3-year Degree candidates must have a **minimum high school GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale**.
- 2. Prior to matriculation, confirm transfer credit equivalent for <u>two</u> college-level courses via:
 - Acceptable AP scores, viewable on the TCNJ Advanced Placement webpage and/or
 - Acceptable IB scores (scoring 5 or higher on the IB exam) and/or
 - College-level courses on an official college transcript with a B grade average

Students in a 3-year program will have a designated 3-year advisor for their major.

They will not be permitted to overload in a semester when taking a writing intensive course, and will complete the 6 units (classes) needed to graduate during the winter session, summer session and/or a one-semester overload each academic year.
